Amendment for IR

From line 279 to 283:

6. neighbouring regions (EU/EEA, North Africa, Middle East, Central Asia) during the whole mandate. An exception can be made if EC member travels to different region for a maximum of 2 months period. In case this is not satisfied, the EC has the right to replace this EC member according to point 3.1.10. All EC members should be coming from the countries of Central and Eastern Europe and located in the countries which are members of the Council of Europe. An exception can be made if an EC member is a resident of a country outside the borders of Member States of the Council of Europe at the moment of their election, in which case the candidate must assure the General Assembly that they will be able to participate following timezones respected in countries of origin of Member Oragnizations. By extending the exemption, the Treasurer and the Secretary-General need to unanimously approve the reimbursement costs for travel by the members of the Executive Committee for which this exemption has been granted. In case an EC member moves from their previous country of origin for a period longer than three months or until the end of their mandate (whichever is shorter), the EC member must adhere to timezones respected in the countries of origin of Member Organizations and their travel costs must be subject to additional approval by the Treasurer and the Secretary-General.
