Dear CDN members,

I am pleased to present my candidacy for the Executive Committee of CDN – a network that has meant a great deal to me personally and to my organisation. I have participated in two General Assemblies and two CDN Summer Camps, including being part of the prep team for the hugely successful 2025 Summer Camp in Moldova. Through this involvement, I have had the privilege of getting to know CDN's wonderful members, the dynamics in the organisation, its strengths and areas for improvement. CDN has supported my organisation *Youth of a Green Future* right from the start, and I want to give back by helping take the network to the next level.

I believe CDN stands at an important crossroads. The network has grown in recent years, the political landscape in Eastern Europe is shifting, and the need to amplify progressive youth voices has never been more urgent. I see enormous untapped potential in CDN and I want to help bridge the gap between where we are and *where we could be*.

What I bring to the table

My background spans research, civil society leadership, and political experience – a combination I believe is uniquely suited to CDN's mission. I graduated from the University of Oxford, and I hold a PhD in Psychology and a Master's in Political Science – an academic foundation that has sharpened my ability to think rigorously about complex social, political, and organisational challenges. As founder and co-president of *Youth of a Green Future*, Bulgaria's first green youth organisation, I have acquired solid experience in strategic development and oversight, project management, fundraising, and partnership-building. I know what it takes to build a resilient and thriving youth organisation, and I want to bring that knowledge to CDN.

My work as a Youth Delegate of Bulgaria to the Congress of Local and Regional Authorities of the Council of Europe has given me expertise in youth participation and the institutional structures of the Council of Europe. My traineeship at the European Commission has made me fluent in EU processes, funding mechanisms, and the opportunities available across the European youth sector. I have also been involved in electoral politics, as the second ever openly gay candidate for parliament in Bulgaria, which has sharpened my understanding of political processes, campaign management, and strategic communication.

My priorities for CDN

If elected to the EC, my work will focus on three areas. First, I want to strengthen CDN's operational capacity by securing EU funding – particularly through Erasmus+ and the European Solidarity Corps and by expanding partnerships with organisations such as Green Forum, the Green European Foundation, FYEG and Heinrich Böll Foundation. My second priority would be the professionalisation of the network: working with experts, developing internal capacity, and supporting member organisations to grow and be impactful. Third, I want to strengthen CDN's strategic positioning in European youth and civil society spaces, ensuring that progressive Eastern European voices are heard where decisions are made.

Whatever I put my heart into, I work hard to make it a success – and I would bring that same energy and commitment to CDN. At the same time, I am approachable and outgoing: I build relationships easily, and I am always eager to help. I believe these qualities are exactly what is needed to be an effective EC member. I am genuinely excited about what we can achieve together. I hope to earn your trust and your vote.
